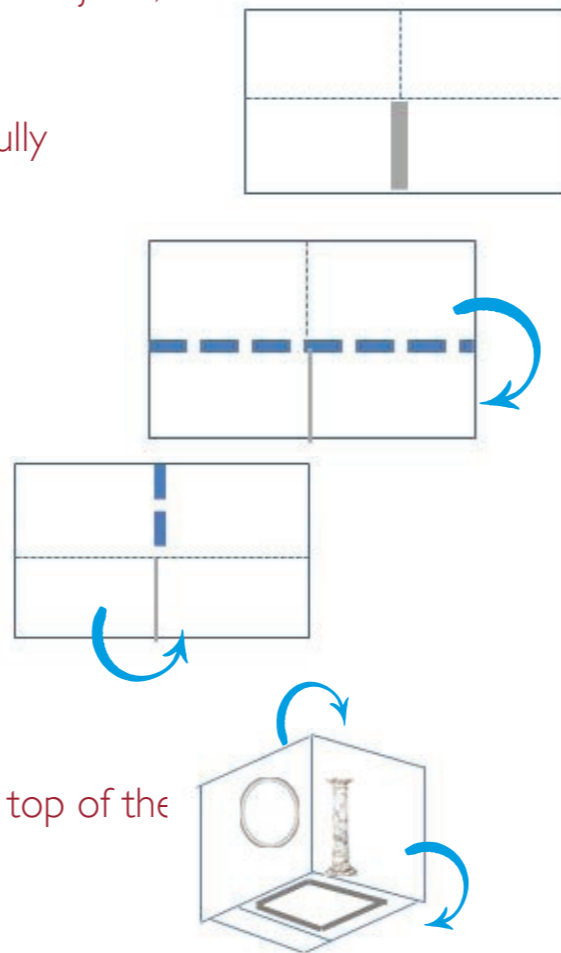
1. On the other side of the page, you will find space to decorate a room in the Palace. The top two squares represent the walls and the bottom two the floor. Get creative and decorate the room by adding new objects, furniture, colours and patterns.

2. Once your design is complete, using scissors, carefully cut the line that divides the bottom two squares.

3. Fold in half horizontally following the dashed line.

4. Fold in half vertically following the dashed line.

5. Make it 3D by sticking the bottom right square on top of the left side square using sticky tape.
